

ENERGIA RESPONSE TO MOYLE RELEVANT ACCESS ARRANGEMENTS FROM 1
OCTOBER 2008 CONSULTATION

Our main comments are:

1. The timings of the auctions do not suit the retail customer base contracting timings. In addition to this, GB power prices are at record highs and are unlikely to look attractive against relatively low SEM prices. Postponing the auctions to August, September and October will match retail customer contracting timings more closely and also increase the opportunity for GB prices to revert to competitive levels.
2. We would like the process for the monthly auctions to move to fax (similar to the DC and NDC processes). This, along with quicker responses to the successful bidders would allow more real-time trading decisions to be made.
3. More transparency is needed around the charges SONI pay to use Moyle post gate closure. Market participants need this to understand and monitor constraint costs.
4. We support the proposals around the publication of summary information on your website.
